

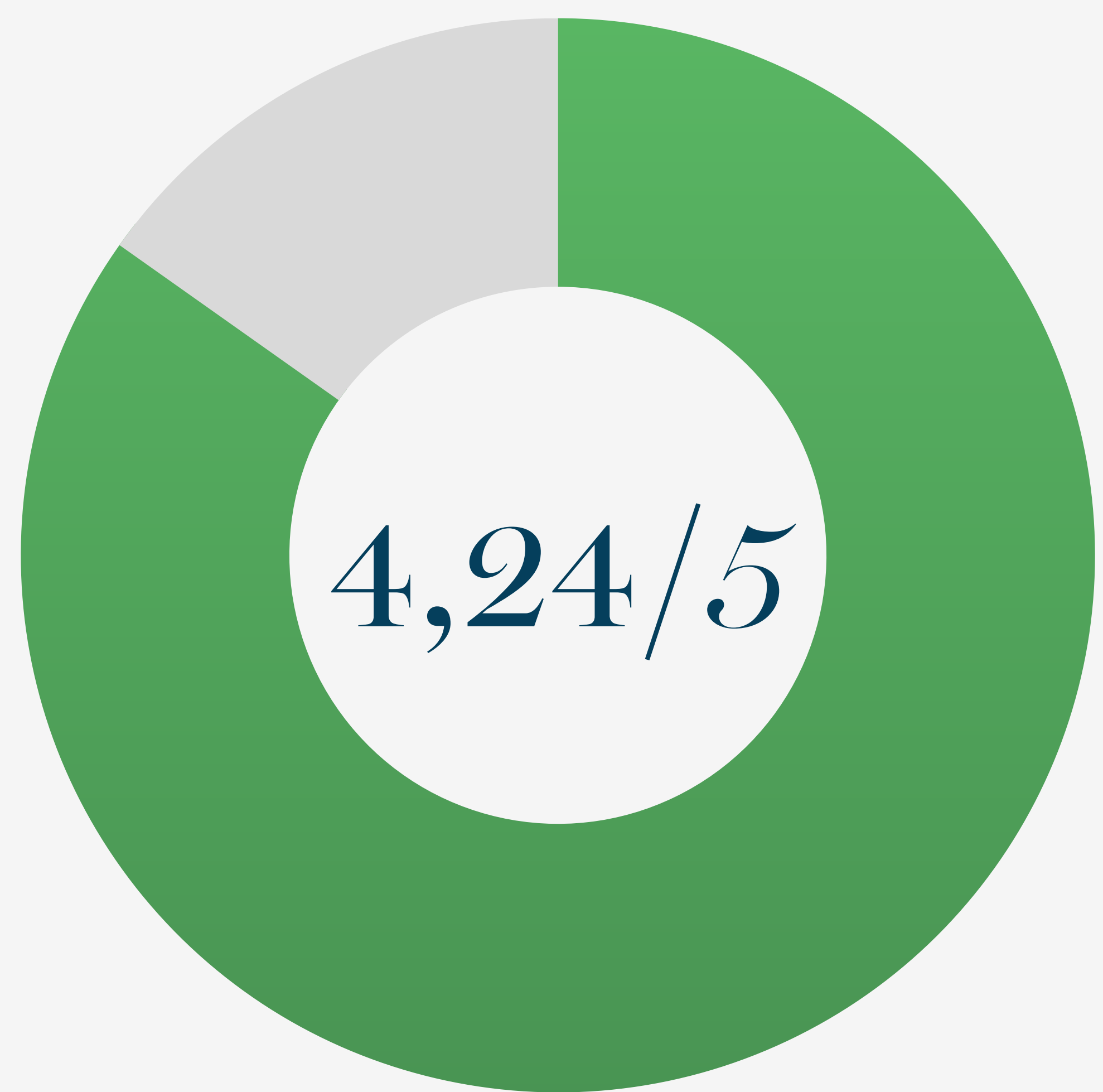
## Shadow report no.2

# 9 steps towards opening the accession negotiations with the European Union

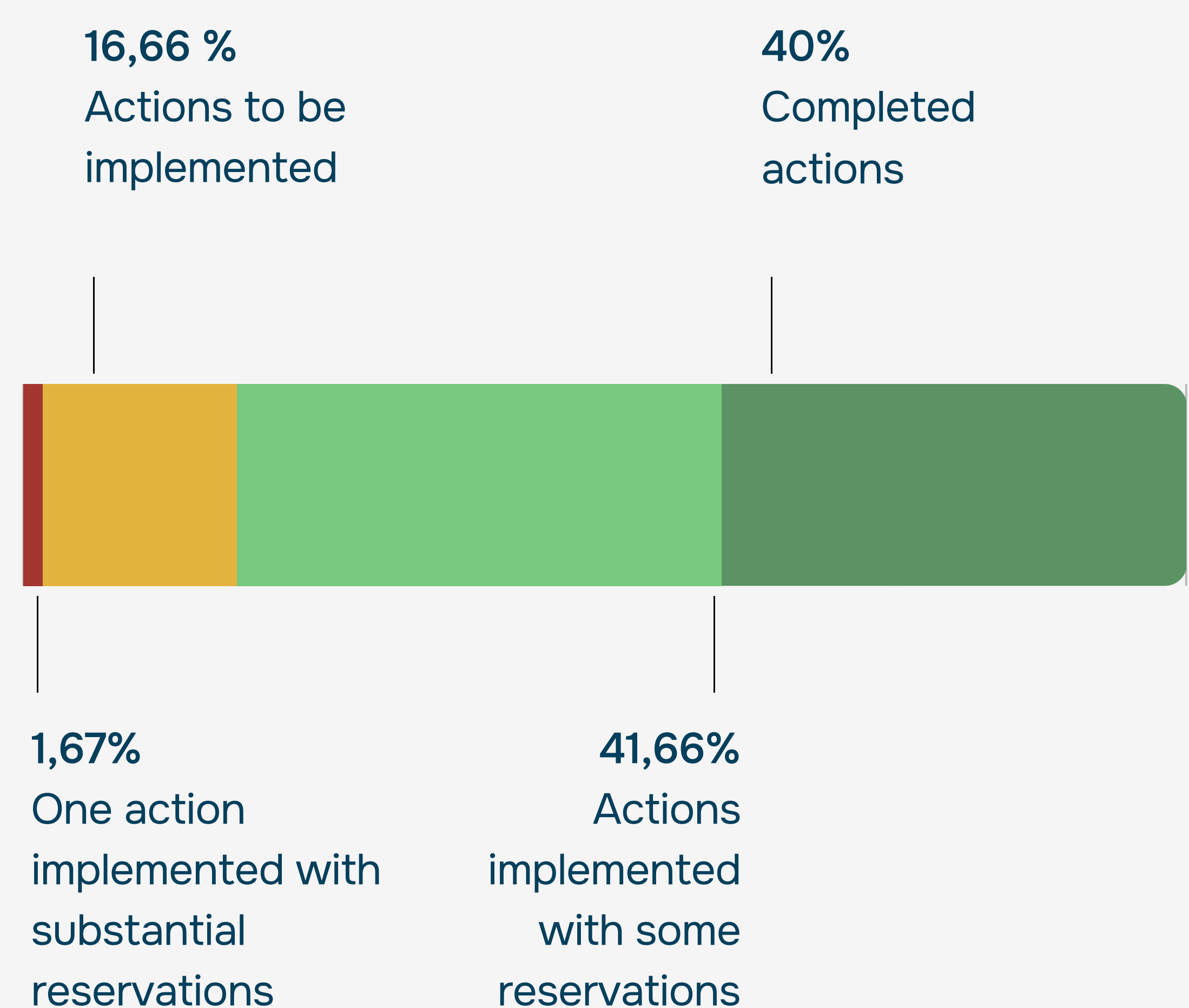
As a result of the updated assessment and the publication of the second shadow report, it is considered that by 30 June 2023, most of the measures have been implemented, with an overall average score of 4,24 points out of the maximum threshold of 5 points.

## The implementation of the 9 measures

Out of the 60 actions corresponding to 9 measures provided by the authorities in the Action Plan: 24 actions (40%) have been completed, 25 actions (41,66%) have been implemented with some reservations, 10 actions (16,66%) are still to be implemented, and one action (1,67%) has been implemented with substantial reservations.



## The list of the 9 steps

The assessments reflected in the first shadow report, published in April 2023, were reviewed and updated to reflect the final evaluations, given that the deadline for fulfilling the 9 commitments was June 2023, when the European Commission initiated the elaboration of the first report within the EU Enlargement Package, which will be published in the autumn of this year.
