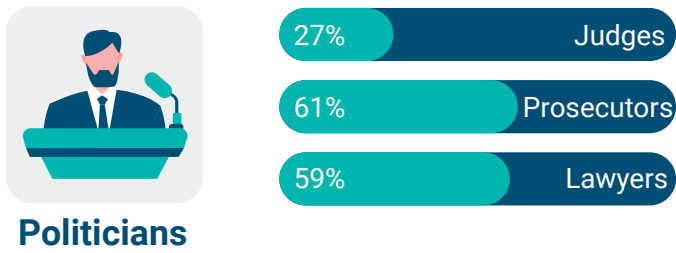

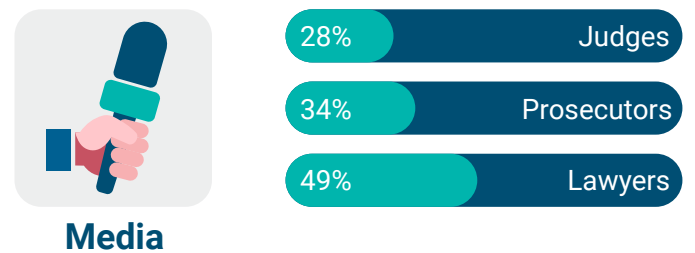
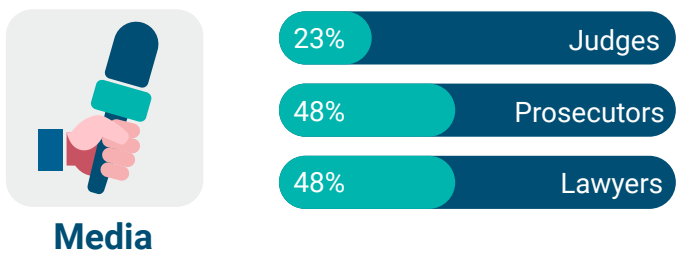
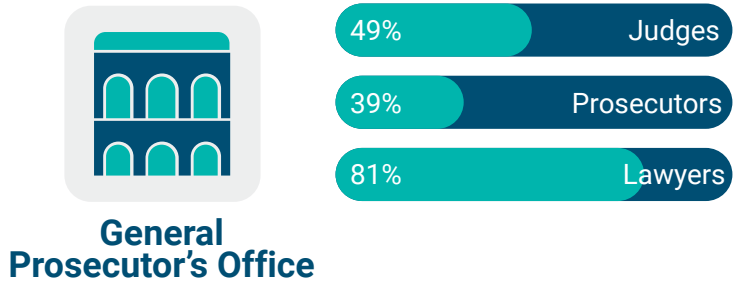
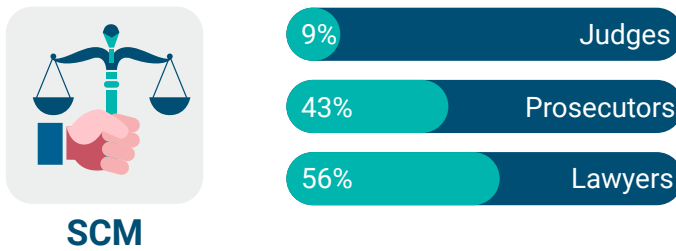
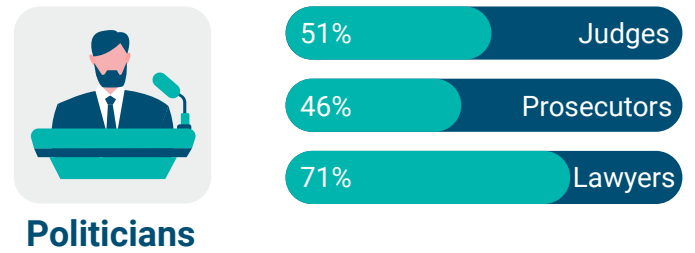


The number of legal professionals who believe that judges and prosecutors are independent has increased over the past three years.

Who influences prosecutors?



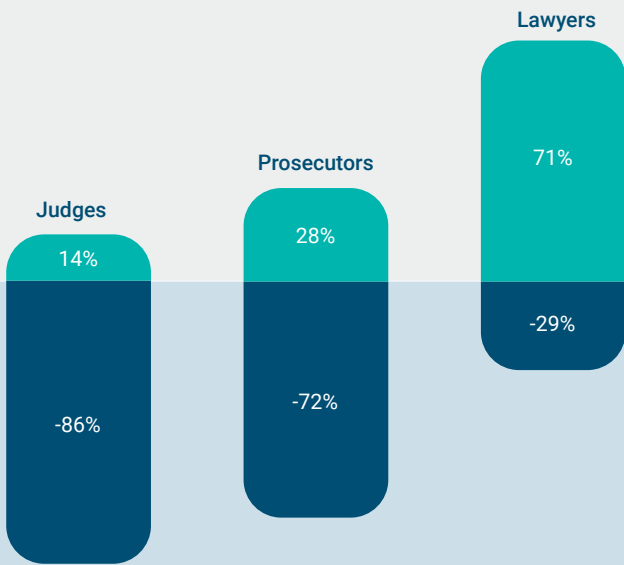
Legal professionals believe that the greatest influence on judges comes from politicians, media outlets, the Supreme Council of the Magistracy, and other judges.

The greatest influence on prosecutors, according to legal professionals, comes from politicians, the Prosecutor General's Office, and media outlets.

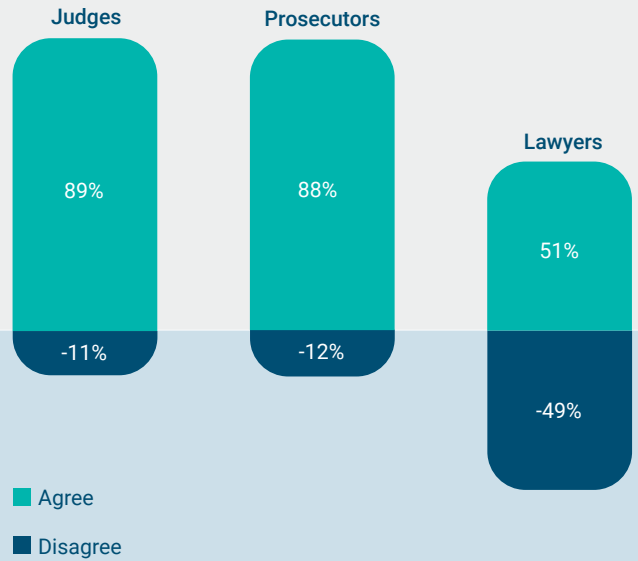


What determined low confidence in justice?

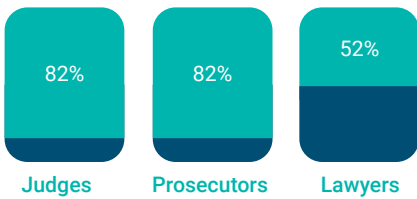
Behavior of the majority of the judges and prosecutors



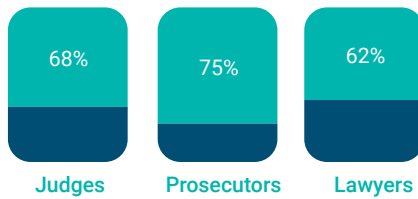
Unjustified image created in the media



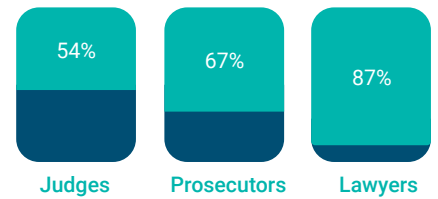
Politicians' attacks
