

31 (28%) Supplemental agendas Published mainly on the day of the meeting, or the day before

94 ^(86%) Published on time




(14%) Published overdue

140 Total agendas

14% of core agendas were published exceeding the legal term.28% of SCP meetings had supplemental agendas.

Subjects examined within the SCP meeting



Half of the subjects on the agendas of the SCP meetings concerned less significant issues.

Public meeting discussions vs. Closed meeting and "Deliberations"




All issues

SCP decisions and their publication


During the monitoring period, 730 decisions were adopted

On average, SCP decisions were published 4 times later than the legally prescribed term.
